

Diagnostic Clinic Policy on Children Accompanying Patients

Purpose:

To ensure the safety of all patients, staff, and visitors, and to maintain a focused and professional environment for the delivery of diagnostic services.

Policy Statement:

While we understand that finding childcare may not always be possible, our priority is to provide a safe, distraction-free environment where patients can receive high-quality diagnostic care.

Policy Guidelines:

1. Children in the Facility:

- Patients may bring children to the clinic; however, children must be supervised by a responsible adult (other than the patient) at all times.
- o **Babies in strollers or carriers** are typically allowed in the waiting room.
- Clinic staff are not permitted to supervise or care for children during a patient's exam.

2. Children in Examination Rooms:

- For safety, infection control, and privacy reasons, children are not permitted in the examination rooms during diagnostic procedures (e.g., ultrasound, X-ray, mammography).
- Exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of clinic management, provided it does not compromise safety or quality of care.

3. Supervision:

 Children should not be left unsupervised in waiting areas or any section of the clinic at any time.

4. Alternative Arrangements:

 If no supervision is available, patients are encouraged to reschedule their appointment to a time when childcare can be arranged.

Communication:

This policy will be communicated to all patients during appointment booking and is available on the clinic's website and reception area.
